On this 29th day of January A D one thousand Eight hundred and fifty one personally appeared before me S B Hammer a justice of the peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, Andrew Lawson a resident of Sevier County Tennessee aged about Sixty Six, who being duly Sworn according to law declares that he is the identical Andrew Lawson who commanded a company as captain in the third Regiment of Tennessee Militia commanded by Colonel Wm Johnson in the war with Great Brittain declared by the United States on the 18th day of June 1812 that he was drafted in Sevier county Tennessee and entered the service at Knoxville Tennessee on the 20th day of September 1814 for the term of Six months and continued in actual service in Said war for more than Six months and was honorably discharged at Knoxville Tennessee on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of May 1815 as will appear by his original certificate of discharge which is filed with commissioner of pensions and by the muster roll of said company

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he may be entitled under the "Act granting bounty land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the military Service of the United States" passed September 28th 1850.
