

This Indenture made the thirteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and thirty between Abraham Mullendore of the County Sevier and state of Tennessee, of the one part, and John Mullendore of the County and state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth. That the said Abraham Mullendore, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to him in hand paid the receipt of which whereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Mullendore a certain piece or Tract of land, lying on the waters of Waldens Creek in the County and state aforesaid. Containing thirty two acres and one half. Bounded as follows Beginning at a stake on Abraham Mullendore's old survey. Running south forty six East nineteen poles to a stake south eighty East twenty four poles to a W.O. Bush, south twenty seven & one half East thirty poles to a B.O. Bush, south forty two East twelve poles to a W. oak north fifty two East thirty two poles to a stake, south twenty eight East, two poles to a stake, north fifty four East, fifty six poles to a horn beam north sixteen west thirty eight poles to a stake, south eighty seven west twenty six poles to a poast oak, south forty seven west, seventy poles to a stake north forty three west sixty eight poles to a stake a corner to A. Waddle, thence with said line south five East thirty five poles to the Beginning. To have and to hold the aforesaid land with all and singular the rights profits appertinances & c of in & to the same belonging or appertaining, to the only proper use of him the said John Mullendore his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Abraham Mullendore for himself his heirs &c against him the said Abraham Mullendore, his heirs &c.
