

Will of Jacob Mullendore, Proven in Frederick, Maryland Court 1771.

"Be it remembered that this fourth day of October in the year of our Lord Seventeen Hundred and Seventy One, I Jacob Mullendore of the County of Frederick and Province of Maryland, being weak in body but in perfect mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of this transitory world do make this my Last Will and Testament touching the disposal of what temporal estate I have, hereby revoking and disannulling all other Wills and Wills hertofore by me made and this only to be taken for my Last Will and Testament and none other.

First- It is my will and I order that in the first place all my just debts and funeral charges be paid and satisfied.

Item- I give unto my well beloved wife Anna, One hundred pounds in lue of her dowry and my best bed and furniture, one new side saddle, one large Bible and herchest with all the furniture that therein is, one Tea Kittle, one small Flour Pot and one large, one Kittle, all which is to be her property and she is not to have any other part of my Estate, real nor personal.

Item- It is my Will and I order that my whole Estate be sold by my Executors, lands and movables and the money be put to use till my children come of age.

Item- It is my will that the whole Estate be equally divided amongst my children Viz: Abraham, Jacob, Elizabeth, David and John and that each of them received their respective legacies when they arrive to their respective ages, with legal interest. It is likewise my will that my Estate shall maintain these children till they arrive to seven years of age, then the boys to be bound out till they come to the age of seventeen years in order for learning and a Christian education, then to be bound to trades until the age of twenty-one years and my daughter till she arrives to the age of sixteen. It is my will that Jacob H Marks my sisters son shall have all my wearing apparel and received Ten Pounds when he comes to the age of twenty one.

My friends Jacob Stoner, Phillip Engler, Andrew Yound and Jacob Nave, I leave, make and ordain my only sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, all and singular my lands and movables to be disposed of by the above my Executors. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the day and year above written.
