Book, loaned by Fred Rawlings, eb. 1954

"M.A. Rawlings commenced boarding with Richard Lanning on the first day of April  
at 1.50 per week 1842.

"Lonsgone to dandridge 10 days April 1842  
lost gone to Dandridge 11 day August 1842.

"Saddle trees Ironed by S. Andes 1852

Side Tree, mans tree , Spanish tree, fall-back tree Solomon Andes was blacksmith.

Dandridge Jan. 5, 1838- \* S.A. Hall in account with M.A. Rawlings, work-  
amounts paid Hall for labor- Side Sadde, mans Saddle, Spanish saddle Bridle  
Rains, "mending seat for hiskins Stage," Saddle baggs, Blind bridle, collars,  
"cutting out pad for Negro," crupper, "Pair of Martingal," stirrup leathers,  
brichbands, Sursingle, girth, fly brush,

Michael A. Rawlings was born the 22nd day of January 1817.

Accounts started at Sevierville, April 1, 1842- located at Dandridge, between  
1838 and 1842. Bought leather of A.J. Thornburgh, A. Lawson, Erabson, S.O.  
Dickey, "Bolt of webbing Inman," "Cloth of McCown and Brabson," Cloth Harris &  
L.W. Inman, leather of A McClain, leather of J Walker, B. Porter, 22 skins,  
Varnish of Dickinson,
